Born in 2004 or before		✓ Eligible when in Grade 7 and until client graduates high school	
Born in 2005 or later			✓ Eligible when in Grade 7 and until client graduates high school

<b>High Risk Clients</b>			
Age	Eligibility*		
	Ineligible	Eligible for HPV-4	Eligible for HPV-9
Men who have sex with men who are 26 years of age or younger		✓ if client has already started the series with HPV4	✓ if client has not already started the series with HPV4

\*Number of doses a client requires depends on the client's age at first dose.

Healthy Females 9-13 years old	2 doses (0, 6months)	2 doses (0, 6months)
Healthy Females 14-45 years old (may need to pay if not eligible through publicly funded criteria)	3 doses (0, 2 and 6 months)	3 doses (0, 2 and 6 months)
Healthy Males 9-13 years old	2 doses (0, 6months)	2 doses (0, 6months)
Healthy Males 14-26 years old (may need to pay if not eligible through publicly funded criteria)	3 doses (0, 2 and 6 months)	3 doses (0, 2 and 6 months)
