## **FNIHB- OR Nursing Policy and Procedure**

# 1. POLICY:

- 1.1 Pets are not permitted in Government Vehicles or Accommodations. The only exception would be that of a service animal.
- 1.2 If a service animal is transported in a government vehicle or cared for in a government accommodation, the service animal must be accompanied by its handler at all times.

#### 2. PRINCIPLES:

- 2.1 Government vehicles and accommodations need to be used by many individuals. Need to consider those individuals who suffer from pet allergies.
- 2.2 FNIHB-OR faces increased costs for maintaining and cleaning accommodations, furniture and vehicle interiors when pets are permitted to stay in nurses residences or transported in government vehicles.
- 2.3 The requirement to share accommodations, common ventilation systems in a block of units, and/or another staff member's allergies prohibit transient staff from bringing a pet with them when on an assignment. Similarly, pets are not allowed to visit or be "pet-sat" in a nursing residence.
- 2.4 Pets outside of the clinic or accommodations may frighten some clients and staff.

### **3. PROCEDURE:**

- 3.1 If the service animal fails to control its bodily eliminations, the handler is responsible for immediately and properly cleaning up and disposing of the waste, whether indoors or outdoors.
- 3.2 The handler of the service animal is responsible for keeping the interior and exterior of the accommodation in a clean condition. Exterior waste must be disposed of promptly and in a proper manner.

- 3.3 The handler of the service animal is responsible for keeping the interior of the vehicle in a clean and odourless condition. All vehicles will be inspected prior to the end date.
- 3.4 The handler of the service animal is responsible for the cost of any extra cleaning or repairs that become necessary because of the service animal.
