1. POLICY:

- 1.1 Nurses are required to be knowledgeable and skilful in the implementation of basic nursing procedures.
- 1.2 Nurses are expected to perform basic nursing skills as outlined in the textbook *Clinical Nursing Skills and Techniques 8th edition* (Perry, Potter, and Ostendorf, 2013).

2. PRINCIPLES:

- 2.1 Ability to perform basic nursing procedures and follow protocols is a professional expectation of a nurse. Basic nursing programs provide theory and clinical practice around basic nursing skills.
- 2.2 Additional nursing and delegated medical functions require the development of specialized competence.

3. DEFINITIONS:

Nurse: Refers to Registered Nurses, Nurse Practitioners, and Registered Practical Nurses.

4. PROCEDURE:

- 4.1 The nurse shall perform basic nursing procedures as outlined in the text book *Clinical Nursing Skills and Techniques 8th edition* (Perry, Potter, and Ostendorf, 2013).
- 4.2 The nurse shall seek consultation from the NIC, physician, or practice consultant as required.
