COVID-19 in Ontario

- COVID-19 continues to circulate in Ontario with increased cases being reported
- All of the province is in <a>Stage 3 of reopening, but on 08 Sep the province announced a "pause" of 4 weeks on further reopening
- Across the province lower limits on unsupervised gatherings are now in place
 - o 10 people at an indoor event or gathering (previous limit of 50); or
 - o 25 people at an outdoor event or gathering (previous limit of 100).
- A free <u>app</u> is available to inform users if they may have been exposed to the COVID-19 virus you can learn more here

Public health measures like watching your distance, washing your hands, and wearing a face covering remain very important

- Avoid crowded places, close contact, and closed spaces
- If gathering, keep 2 m distance between others who are not in your social circle
- Wear a <u>face covering</u> (cloth mask, non-medical mask) when running essential errands where you'll be indoors – some areas of Ontario require you to wear a face covering – find more information about how masks help here and here
- Stay home and self-isolate if you are sick, feel unwell, or have symptoms of COVID-19

COVID-19 FNIHB-OR Epi Report

- As of September 21st, 2020, we have 68 First Nations confirmed cases and 6 non-First Nations. Of those cases, 62 or 95% have resolved. We currently have 10 active cases.
- Since the beginning of the pandemic, there have been 2 deaths.
- In total, 5,777 tests have been reported to FNIHB-OR.
- A grand total of 13,516 tests (including tests done in SLFNHA and WAHA areas).
- As of September 21st, there were 47,274 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Ontario. That is an increase of 425 confirmed cases which is the largest increase in three months.
- As of September 21st, 175 new cases were recorded in Toronto, 84 in Peel 60 in Ottawa and 20 in York Region. All other public health units reported 15 or fewer cases.
