SUBJECT Well Child Kit

In follow up to the 4 NDDS/LookSee education sessions this year, each community will receive a ‘well child kit’ for use during well child visits.

 - NDDS/LookSee checklist
 - can be reordered through Stores
 - Rourke Baby Record – 1 visit/page format
 - Available on Onehealth.ca

- a) Tools to be used for developmental screening using LookSee/NDDS tool.
 - Please clean between use
 - Must be reordered via purchasing (not in Stores)

REMINDER:

1. Frequency of Well Child Visits

Each newborn should be seen within 24-48 hours after return to community.

After this visit, children must be assessed at below intervals and annually thereafter.

Children with risk factors should be seen more frequently than below.

1 wk	2 wk	1 mth	2 mth	4 mth	6 mth	9 mth	12 mth
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18 mth	2 yr	3 yr	4 yr	5 yr	6 yr
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2. Components of EVERY well child visit:

Rourke Baby Record	LookSee Checklist (NDDS)	WHO Growth Chart	Immunizations	Vital Signs incl. BP	Parental Support & Education
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Any Growth and Development concerns identified on Rourke/NDDS/Growth Chart must be followed up. This necessitates appropriate CHN referrals, as per SLZ Early Childhood Development Referral Pathway, **PLUS** referral to MD/NP.
