Course Description

This 20 minute course covers the section added to the newest version of Basic Safety Training that address Fleet Vehicle User responsibilities and distracted driving. It helps to ensure that FNHA is compliant with the BC Occupational Health and Regulation parts 3.22 to 3.25 **Young or New Workers** regulation for low-risk worksites and the *Motor Vehicle Act*.

Prerequisites

There is no prerequisite for this course.

Training/Learning Outcomes

After completion of this course, the participants will be able to:

- List fleet vehicle pre-use requirements
- Itemize fleet vehicle user responsibilities
- Identify safety equipment needed for use of personal or rental vehicles
- Identify options in the event of personal injury
- Describe distracted driving hazards and organizational expectations
- Identify what incidents to report and how to report vehicle incidents

Target Audience

This course is mandatory for all FNHA employees who completed the original FNHA Basic Safety Training prior to January 4, 2017 and who drive FNHA fleet vehicles.

New, newly transferred/promoted employees or current employees who have never taken the FNHA Basic Safety Training should take Basic Safety Training v. 3 instead of this course. Version 3.0 is also available on the Learning Space.
